# BIG 5 GAME DRIVE- 3 HOUR SAFARI

Enjoy a morning or afternoon drive on a reserve close to Hoedspruit (40 km from Kingfisher Creek). We have a choice of 2 private reserves to safari in, speak to reception about the best option for you. Enjoy a wide variety of game such as lion, cheetah, elephant,, leopard and general game. AM/PM drives available. The safari drive takes 3 hours.

## MANYELETI GAME RESERVE- HALE DAY

Big 5

The Manyeleti Game reserve is a 23,000-hectare game reserve which borders the Kruger National Park. There are no fences between the Kruger and the Manyeleti so the game can roam freely, however, the volumes of people are significantly less here so you can enjoy a quieter game viewing experience. Morning Manyeleti drives depart at 5am, Afternoon Manyeleti drives depart at 2pm return you to the lodge in time for dinner. Don't forget your binoculars!



## **OUAD BIKE SAFARI**

Join us for a 1.5hr Quad bike trail at Buffaloland, a Big 3 reserve. The track will take you through various landscapes with amazing views of the local plains and wildlife. Animals that can be observed on this journey include Buffalo, Leopards, Lions, Giraffes, Kudu, Wildebeest, Ostriches, Baboons, and an abundance of birdlife. Drivers need to be 16 yrs + for this trail. Passengers welcome up to 16 years.

# PANORAMA ROUTE -FULL DAY

The Panorama route is home to the Blyde River canyon which is the third largest canyon in the world. After collection at Kingfisher Creek your tour begins at the spectacular 3 Rondawels, overlooking the canyon and from there, you slowly work your way along the various scenic beauty sights that encompass the Panorama route.

For those seeking adventure an additional stop can be requested in Graskop Gorge (ADDITIONAL COST) to experience The Viewing Lift & Forest Walk, The Big Swing, The Zipline or the suspension bridge.



### BLYDE CANYON BOAT CRUISE

Blyde Canyon Safaris, offer scenic boat trips on the Blyde Dam. This is your opportunity to see the famous Three Rondawels and the Blyde River Canyon from the angle it's supposed to be seen: while you're on the water, at the base of the towering mountains that form these breath-taking sights. Tick off those last couple of birds that have been eluding your bird list and enjoy seeing the hippo's and crocodiles that make this dam their home. The boat tour is 1.5 hrs & trip times are: 9am, 11am, 1pm & 3pm

## MOHOLOHOLO WILDLIFE REHABILITATION CENTRE

The Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre contributes to the conservation of endangered species and the rehabilitation of injured & poisoned wildlife. Animals to be seen are: Lion, Leopard, Hyena, Cheetah, Serval, Lynx, Honey Badger, Eagles, Vultures, Wild Dogs

Tours are twice daily Monday- Saturday (CLOSED ON SUNDAY): 09.30 & 15:00 Duration- 2 Hours



### BLYDE CANYON COMBO EXPERIENCE

The day starts with a visit to Moholoholo Rehabilitation Centre, followed by a walk in the Blyde River Canyon to a waterfall where you will enjoy a picnic (bring your swimming cozzie) End the day with a Boat Cruise in the canyon before being brought back to the lodge . You are collected at 8 am and return at 5pm. The rate includes: Transfers, entry fees & a picnic.



# ROOTS OF RHYTHM TRIBAL DANCE SHOW

# HOT AIR BALLOONING

Experience the magic of lighter-than-air flight near the foot of the Drakensberg Escarpment. On offer is a 1hr long flight over the scenic lowveld section of the Blyde River, 15 km West of Hoedspruit.



# VILLAGE WALKING TOUR

This 2.5 hour walking tour takes you through Sigagula Village with a tour guide. The tour will walk you through the village explaining the culture and traditions of the African people from this area. You will make a stop at Songoma (a highly respected African traditional healer). Light refreshments are provided. Collection & drop off back at Kingfisher Creek are included.



# SCENIC FLIGHT

Choose from a 30-minute game viewing flight on a Bantam and feel the wind in your hair or feel as free as a bird in a Jabiru and take a 30-minute flight over the Blyde River Canyon or 60min game viewing flight. Flights are operated in the mornings from Hoedspruit Civil airport in town and the maximum weight limit is 100kg for the Bantam and 120kg for the Jabiru . Flights are operated with 1 pilot and 1 passenger.



## HELICOPTER FLIGHT OVER CANYON

Experience the largest Green Canyon in the world from the comfort of a 3 passenger helicopter.

The helicopter will collect you from Guernsey Private Nature Reserve and route towards the Blyde River Canyon. During this flight you will get a unique perspective of the Kadishi waterfall, Three Rondawels, Blyde River, Burke's Luck Potholes, Treur and Belvidere Rivers. Exiting the area towards the Lowveld through Devil's Window will take your breath away!

#### **COURSE INFO**

Duration: 3 hours

Appropriate for children aged 6 – 15 years.

Our junior ranger course is an interactive and practical course, suitable for children from 6 upwards. The course

lasts approximately 3 hours and is led by experienced field guides. It is an exciting and fun introduction to understanding the South African bush.

**Topics covered include:** 

### ANIMAL TRACKING

We will take a short walk into the bush, identifying and following animal tracks.

# ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION

Looking into the famous 'Big 5' and the many species of plains game and birds found on Guernsey Nature Reserve.

### ANIMAL BEHAVIOUR

Learning how animals communicate and interact with one another as well as observing animals safely.

# ANIMAL CALLS

Africa's birds and animals have some of the world's most distinctive calls. While out on our bush walk we will try to identify a few of these.

### **DUNG IDENTIFICATION**

Investigate various types of animal dung discovering what the animal eats and fi nd out which animal it belongs to.

### **INSECTS**

Observe species such as termites, butterflies and some of the 'Small 5' such as the 'Ant lion' and 'Rhinoceros beetle'.

#### TREES AND PLANTS

Have you ever made your own toilet paper or toothbrush from a tree? Join us on the course to find out how!

### **BUSH NAVIGATION**

How to find your way in the bush using the sun and natural indicators.

#### SMALL SURVIVAL SKILLS

How to find water and food in the bush as well as 'bush medicine'.

Heading back to the boma to make a fi re... the first one to create flames wins a prize!






# KRUGER PARK GOLFING



The Skukuza Golf Course is a magnificent 9-hole (18-tee) course situated in the world-renowned Kruger National Park on the outskirts of Skukuza Rest Camp.

The rich wildlife sanctuary surrounding the golf course is home to the Big Five, a huge variety of birds and countless animals, which all conspire to provide the visitor with a harmonious close-to-nature golfing experience. The golf course was built in 1972 as a recreational facility for the Skukuza personnel, and has now been opened to visitors to the Kruger National Park for the first time.

The course is a Par 72, and is 5831m (6450 yards) for men and 4950m (5480 yards) for women. Since the course is not fenced-in, uninvited spectators are a common sight; hippo, impala, warthog and baboons to mention but a few. The course offers the pleasure of challenge and adventure. The Skukuza Golf Course has no bunkers, although 'aerial bunkers' abound because of the many trees found on the course.
